The school serves families in the village and wider area. It is a small rural school with a roll of 113 pupils. Currently we have 4 classes covering mixed age groups. The school remains on its original site at the centre of the village. The attractive Victorian building is the heart of the school, enhanced by the modern hall and computer suite and library. We are very proud of our school buildings and grounds and the facilities are regularly used by the school and the wider community. As a Voluntary Controlled school we enjoy an active and valued relationship with the village church.
