Kenya Partnership Visit



Mr Evans returned safely last Sunday from visiting our partner school, St Paul's in Kutus, Kenya. Here is his report.

The trip was in doubt right up until the last minute because of security concerns but I am so glad that in the end it went ahead. As always I was welcomed with open arms by all the teachers and pupils at St Paul's and they were even more pleased to see me than ever.

I spent four days visiting all the classes in the school from the 4 year olds up to the 13/14 year olds in Standard 8.

The youngest children loved hearing the stories of 'The Hungry Caterpillar' and 'The Gruffalo' and they entertained me with some lovely songs, some of which I hope to teach to the children at St Mary's.

The older classes enjoyed reading the tour guides to Dedham and Essex which Classes 3 and 4 had produced and they created some guides to their local area which I have brought back.

We also exchanged designs for crosses to decorate our classrooms as part of the Chelmsford Diocese Centenary celebration. I also took some pop-up goals and we had fun playing handball on the school field. The school has continued to make good progress academically this year with three children going onto 'National Schools', comparable to our Grammar schools.

Their English test results were among the best in the County. They have also been able to build another new classroom which they hope will become their 'ICT suite' when they eventually receive the new laptops promised to every primary school by the Kenyan Government.

Sadly after four days it was time to say 'kwaheri', but the partnership will continue with two more teachers from St Paul's coming to visit us in September.
