She has worked with the school for a long time now and most of the children have met her before. She explained what having diabetes meant, the differences between Type 1 and Type 2 and how everyone can help if they are needed.

Daniel and his mum were on hand as well to answer any questions that the children had. The children learnt about the condition and were more understanding of what 'Type Onesie Day' actually meant.

I am delighted to inform you that we raised a grand total of £104 which we will be sending to the Diabetes Association.
