
In the 'Cup' Final, the 'A' team were unlucky to lose to Great Oakley - 7v6 in extra time, to finish runners up for the second year in succession.

Well done to both teams - they worked hard and demonstrated a high level of sportsmanship:



Operation Christmas Child Shoe Boxes

Amanda will be launching our 2015 campaign on Monday and as a result flyers with information about the appeal will be sent out that day.

Mrs Brotzman, (Daniel Cardew's Mum - Class 2) has been collecting shoe boxes for many years and has some helpful advice, especially if this appeal is new to you.

"If anyone cannot afford, or cannot find the time to pack a complete shoebox, how about sending in some 'filler' items instead? Or how about donating the left over bits that wouldn't fit in your box to be used as 'fillers' too?

Upon reaching the processing centre, every shoebox is checked to ensure the contents are suitable for the child due to receive the box, and that they comply with customs regulations. Items often have to be removed such as perishable foods like chocolates which leaves many boxes only half filled.

Supplying 'fillers' would greatly assist the operation and help to fill up those boxes left half full.

Some great ideas for filler items include toothbrushes, hair combs, bars of soap, lollypops, soft toys, finger puppets, toy cars, hats, gloves, colouring books, crayons, stationary and school items. Filler items are essential, and by supplying them you will help ensure that every child who receives a shoebox this year, will receive a full one, bursting with gifts and treats.
