Children in Need

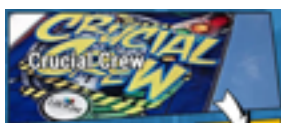
Last Friday we joined in with the Children in Need appeal with the children coming to school as Super Heroes!

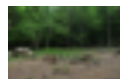
